5. LUNCHESES

The registration fee does not include lunches, so you will need to either i) go to a nearby restaurant (there are only about 10 small restaurants near the venue, as well as one inside the venue), ii) go to the nearby supermarket or a convenience store, or iii) order a lunch box from the registration desk (the day before). Please bear in mind that the lunch break is only about 1 hour in duration. The cheapest option is ii), but they cannot cater for 100 people. We recommend that most people choose option iii), as this option will give you plenty of time to enjoy lunch and still make it to the afternoon session on time. Additionally, you will be able to choose your box lunch from an illustrated, translated menu; lunch menus at the local restaurants may be only in Japanese with no pictures. For those of you wishing to order boxed lunches, please give us some idea of the type of meal you'd like to eat. Later on we will provide some illustrated examples and price lists as downloadable pdfs on the INA 13 home page. Typically, boxed lunches consist of rice (usually 1/3 of the contents), meat, vegetables/seaweed, and fruit, each in separate compartments; however, there are many variations. Box lunches typically cost between 300~1000 JPY.

7. POST-CONFERENCE FIELDTRIPS
